Oh My Pie checked off High End Cash on the first turn and subsequently fell. Oh My Pie underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Birmingham contacted the running rail on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have abrasions to the left front toes and right hind tibia. A 3 day stand down period was imposed.

12:52 pm 395m Grade 6 A sample was taken from Braemar Molly upon arrival at the course.

Harley was quick to begin. Dr. Kenneth was slow to begin.

Harley underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have left foreleg spike wound. A 3 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr. Gregory Mills regarding the racing manners of Harley on the home turn and in the home straight. After hearing submissions from Mr Mills, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections regarding the greyhound's racing manners.

A post-race sample was taken from Black Viper - the winner of the event.

1:52 pm 450m Mixed 4/5 A pre-race sample was taken from Daintree Damage.

Daintree Damage was quick to begin.

Dr. Benedict contacted the running rail on the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hind abrasion. A3 day stand down period was imposed.

SPORTSBET MAKE IT A MULTI 2:17 pm 450m Grade 5 Mr. Jordan Carrodus-nagy failed to kennel Harry The Hood by the appointed kennelling time. A warning was issued pursuant to LR 39.1

Harry The Hood and River Matt were slow to begin.

River Matt lost ground approaching the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hindleg back muscle injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

River Matt – Stewards were satisfied with the boxing of the greyhound and removed the boxed first endorsement for future events, in accordance with GAR 106.

A post-race sample was taken from Dr. Farrah - the winner of the event.

Satisfactory Trial:

Head Bin underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have right back muscle injury and right pencil/whip injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.
