Rac AUSSIE SECI 10:54 350	RET @ STUD 4 am	Stalking Douglas – Late scratching at 4:01pm (11/6/24) when Ms Cindy Fulford reported the greyhound to have a groin injury (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted. A sample was taken from Percival upon arrival at the course.

A sample was unable to be obtained from Got Flair upon arrival at the course, a pre-race sample was subsequently taken.

Percival and Rockin' Queenie were quick to begin.

A sample was taken from Bang On Blue upon arrival at the course. Leonardo Zeal and Ruby's Bingo were quick to begin. Ruby's Bingo was severely checked on the first turn and subsequently tailed off underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 5. Ruby's Bingo was found to have a left monkey muscle injury and a spike wound to the left hind toe. A 7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr Peter McKenzie regarding Ruby's Bingo's overall performance in the event. In accordance with GAR 122, the Stewards requested Mr. McKenzie to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Ruby's Bingo in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.
A post-race sample was taken from Leonardo Zeal - the winner of the event.

Gracilis visibly eased, turned its head to the inside soon after the start and pulled up underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 7 – no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mr Matthew Tabb regarding Gracilis' racing manners soon after the start. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Gracilis was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Tabb pleaded guilty to the charge. Gracilis was suspended for 28 days at Traralgon and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
